Pike Rigs and Traces - February 12

On Wednesday 12th February there will be a session focusing on Pike Fishing, and specifically on pike rigs. This will be a practical session with instruction on how to make a variety of pike rigs with an emphasis on fish safety.

Those attending will be able to have a go at making up rigs that they can take away and use in their own fishing.

Line, Knots and Shotting Patterns - March 18

If you want to hook and land more fish then there's nothing more important than presenting your bait correctly using the right line with the right knots. Come and learn from two top RDAA anglers - Lewis Read (Product Development Manager for Gardner and now Thinking Anglers) and Mike Dalziel (Drennan sponsored match angler and RiverFest finalist)

The session is primarily aimed at the general angler who would benefit from gaining a better understanding of the best lines to use in different situations and the knots needed to give you the best chance of landing your target fish. In addition we will cover the basics of shotting patterns and bait presentation to help you get more bites.
