

BEALE PARK FISHERY, PANGBOURNE

Day Tickets:

We are pleased to announce a new partnership with Beale Park Angling which will give RDAA members exclusive day ticket access to one and half miles of one of the most popular and productive stretches of the Thames on the west bank just upstream of Pangbourne. Beale Park once held the world match fishing record and is still renowned for big catches of bream in the right conditions along with specimen perch, pike, carp and chub. There is a very good head of roach present too. Day tickets are only available to RDAA members and must be booked in advance via Clubmate.

Cost:

£10 day ticket RDAA Members only via Clubmate

Fishing is on the river only (not the lake) and from 8am until dusk. Parking is in the new anglers car park just along from the main Beale Park car park off Shooter Hill (A329), Lower Basildon, Pangbourne, Reading, RG8 9NW.

Access and Parking:

Parking is in the new anglers car park just along from the main Beale Park car park off Shooter Hill (A329), Lower Basildon, Pangbourne, Reading, RG8 9NW and at the upstream end of the fishery in Church Lane. Both are secured via combination padlocks. The codes will be on your separate Clubmate booking email.

Access:

Head through the main entrance on A329 Shooters Hill (Gate opens from 8am)
Follow the road round to the left past the new gatehouse and then bear right down towards the main car park and then round to the to the large double metal gate facing the field with the lake on the right. Access through here using the combination padlock code which will be on your Clubmate booking email and park just beyond the gates.

What3Words- electric.legroom.swimmer

Keeping the lake on your right walk along the path to the small river gate and open with the second combination padlock code. This brings you out in the middle of the stretch behind the second island.

There is a second locked car park at the upstream end of the fishery in Church Lane as shown on the map. Again this is via combination padlock code.

Leaving the fishery:

When leaving the complex, drive north following the exit signs to the church end of Beale Park and the two gates will open when you drive up to them.... (an emergency code will be provided in case the gates don't open).

Rules:

RDAA general rules apply although these may be supplemented by any further requirements from Beale Park Angling. A full copy of the fishery rules can be found here -

Syndicate Membership:

Beale Park Angling operates two syndicates for its members. The night fishing season ticket is £100 and the day only season ticket is currently £60 both with a £5 joining fee for the first season. However, they have kindly agreed to offer a limited number of places on both the day and night syndicates to RDAA members at a reduced rate of £65 (night) and £40 (day only) plus joining fee.
